


Safety at School Bus Stops What Students Should Know



Students crossing in front of the school bus cannot see a vehicle approaching from behind the bus.

When waiting for the bus:

- Stay a safe distance from the roadway.
- No pushing or horseplay.
- When it arrives, stay away from the wheels.

When crossing in front of the bus:

- After exiting the bus, walk at least three giant steps from the side of the bus.
- Walk on the sidewalk or side of the road, taking 10 giant steps ahead of the bus.
- Look at the driver for a signal to cross.
- Stop at the edge of the bus.
- Look to the left, right and left again.
- Keep watching the traffic as you walk.
- If some of your papers or personal items fall under the school bus, ask the bus driver to help you.
